

## Welcome to the Society!

We hope that you will enjoy being a member and that you will be successful in the search for your Glamorgan ancestors.

*Membership Year*: Our membership year runs from 1 April to 31 March irrespective of what time of the year you join.

**Quarterly Journals:** Members receive four journals a year published in March, June, September and December. You can also access previous editions in the Journal Archives on our website.

Membership Number: Your membership number will be notified to you by our membership team. It will also be shown on the journal envelope and in your Profile when you log into the website. Keep your membership number safe, because you will need to quote it in all correspondence with the Society.

Website Members' Only Area: At present this contains three of our burial/MI indexes and our journal archive. Further research material will be added later.

## To log in and reset your password:

- A verification code will be sent to you (check your spam box if you do not receive this email)
- Click on the link in the email and the verification code will be copied.
- You will then be able to change your password to something more memorable.

Standing Orders: A Standing Order Form is included with this pack and should be forwarded to your bank. This type of payment is not available for new members since your membership number must be quoted. Standing Orders are processed in January each year.

Gift Aid (UK members only): You can help the Society by Gift Aiding your membership fee. This is a "one off" procedure - complete a Gift Aid Form (available on our website and with this pack), making sure that you have read the conditions on the form.

### Members Interests & Help Wanted

You are invited to submit your surname interests and 'Help Wanted' items (max 100 words) for publication in the next available journal and on the website. A Member's Interests form is included with this pack or you can download one from the website. Margaret will arrange for your interests to be placed in both the journal and on our website.

How Your Personal Details are used

- a) Your full membership details are stored on a membership database for Society use only;
- b) We sometimes pass on your contact details to branch secretaries and other members of the administration team. Should other Society members identify similar research interests you will be contacted by the membership team who will pass on contact details of the other member. This will allow you to contact the member directly should you wish to do so. Your details are not passed on to other members without your expressed consent. Telephone numbers are never shared.
- c) On our Members' Interests List on our website your contact details are omitted, you are identified only by your membership number.
- d) Our membership subscription database on the website contains only your name, address, telephone number and email this is available only to our web admin team and is not shared with anyone else.
- e) Your name and address is shared quarterly with our printers in order to produce a mailing list for the journal to be posted.
- f) Membership details are deleted six months after a member's subscription lapses apart from information required to be retained for HMRC Gift Aid purposes.

You should inform us in writing WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS if you have any objection to your data being stored in the ways described above,

### About the Society

The Society started in 1974 and was known as the Heraldic & Genealogical Society of Wales. This changed in 1976 to the South Wales Family History Society and in 1983 to the Glamorgan Family History Society. The Glamorgan FHS is a member of the Welsh Association of Family History Societies (AFHSW), South West Area Group (SWAG) and also a member of the world wide Federation of Family History Societies.

The declared aim of the Society is to offer advice and to help members do their own research, but for those who live some distance from Glamorgan, a limited amount of help is offered, and a list of 'Look Up' services for members is included. Please try to address your request to the correct person to save time. If you have a very specific research query, then write to the Branch Secretary of that area, or insert a short 'Help Wanted' item in the Journal. (Send directly to the Editor, max 100 words).

When writing, please bear in mind that all society officers and postholders help the Society in their own time, often juggling jobs and family commitments, as well as trying to help answer letters from over a thousand members.

Branch Secretaries might well take your letter to their next monthly meeting, so we ask you to be patient and not expect an answer by return of email/post. Overseas members requiring a postal reply, will be responsible for the cost of postage. Cheques must be in STERLING and made payable to Glamorgan FHS. All the money from subscriptions, publication sales, etc is put back into the Society, to provide members with as good a service as possible and to enable us to increase the number of research aids, such as parish register and monumental inscriptions' indexes, etc that we publish.
